FTCE Review Workshop | Program | Series Course Descriptions

General Knowledge/Writing Fast-Track Series [Includes: GK-Fast-Track Workshop--A1 and GK-Writing Fast-Track Workshop--A2]

This program series is set up as a one-day event which includes a general review of English Language Skills, Critical Reading, and Mathematics in the first portion and a Writing Workshop in the second portion. The first portion of the day will be a refresher on the key concepts found on the FTCE General Knowledge Exam—Essay Writing, English Language Skills, Critical Reading and Mathematics. The instructor will provide sample test questions as well as a full-length practice exam with a solution guide for future reference. This part of the day is designed for learners that need a brush-up on the key skills and concepts that are found on each part of the examination. This session is focused on fast-paced, intensive review for participants. The FTCE General Knowledge Refresher will last six hours which will be divided into two three hour sessions.

The last portion of this day-long workshop is a hands-on experience focused on learners mastering the key skills needed to successfully complete the Essay Writing portion of the FTCE General Knowledge Exam. The instructor will aid participants in understanding the key components of the process: A Sound Thesis Statement, Relevant Topic Sentences, Useful Transition Devices, Analytical Sentence Structure, Focused Organization, and Thorough Position Development. The Writing Workshop will last for three hours and will provide the learner with an in-depth understanding of what must be done to accomplish a passing score. Beyond participating at the workshop, each participant will be able to send essays to the instructor for a couple of weeks to ensure that the learner is fully prepared to take the assessment.
